2. Types of Cookies We Use

a. Essential Cookies

- Required for the operation of the Services.
- Enable core features such as authentication, security, and user sessions.
- Without these cookies, the Services may not function properly.

b. Performance and Analytics Cookies

- Collect information about how you use the Services.
- Help us analyze traffic, usage patterns, and improve performance.
- Examples include Google Analytics cookies.

c. Security and Reliability Cookies

- Used to enhance security, detect abuse, and prevent fraudulent activity.
- Examples include cookies set by **Cloudflare** for traffic routing and DDoS protection.

d. Functionality Cookies

Allow us to remember your preferences and provide enhanced functionality (e.g., language settings).

e. Advertising and Marketing Cookies

- Used to deliver relevant ads and measure the effectiveness of our campaigns.
- May be set by us or third-party partners.
- Examples include retargeting cookies and cookies from advertising networks.

3. Third-Party Cookies

We may allow trusted third-party partners (such as analytics, security, and advertising providers) to set cookies when you use our Services. These third parties may collect information about your online activities across different websites and services, in accordance with their own privacy policies.

4. Legal Basis for Using Cookies

- In the **European Union, UK, and Brazil**, we rely on **user consent** for non-essential cookies, in line with GDPR and LGPD.
- In **California**, users have the right to opt out of the "sale" or "sharing" of personal information under CCPA/CPRA.
- In **Mexico (LFPDPPP)**, cookies must be disclosed and managed transparently, and consent must be obtained for non-essential cookies.
